The Institutional Biosafety Committee (IBC), appointed by the Director of Regulatory Affairs, is charged with developing procedural guidelines specifically applicable to Georgetown University for research activities that are concerned with recombinant DNA, extremely dangerous viruses and carriers of viruses potentially harmful to humans. It will disseminate approved guidelines to all faculty involved in this type of research and will keep them apprised of new regulations which may be developed in the future. The IBC is also charged with periodically reviewing and making appropriate projections and/or recommendations regarding safety precautions and facilities that are necessary for conducting this type of research as well as for the unscheduled monitoring of ongoing research activity in this area to insure adherence to the established safety guidelines.
